SWMRIC Goes Green

SWMRIC is addressing the "green features" in a residential property by adding a new "Green Features Section" to the Residential Data Input Form. This new section is divided into two parts: Green Features and Green Certification/Rating. If you check yes for "Green Features and Seller's Green Disclosure Statement Attached to the Listing on the MLS?" a Seller's Green Disclosure Statement explaining the type of features the property contains must be completed by the Seller and added as an attached document to the listing in SWMRIC. The items should be checked in the Green Section of the Data Input Form.

A "Yes" in the Green Feat & Disclos box opens the features shown below. Leave the box blank, or "No", if you do not have a signed Seller's Green Disclosure Statement.



If the property has a Green Certification/Rating, select "Yes" in the Green CERT/RATING box then complete the appropriate information on the data input screen which opens below. The year the property was certified or rated is required.

Attach a copy of Certificate of Certification or Rating Documentation to the listing as an attached document. If the seller does not have the required documentation, you will not be able to claim the listing is certified or rated. The Seller will also need to complete the Seller's Green Disclosure Statement, which must also be attached to the listing in the MLS through an attached document.

In addition to the new Green Features sections, you'll find some new selections in the Exterior Materials and Air Conditioning features. Also, a new feature, Water Heater, has been added. There is one new feature related to the status of New construction shown on the data input form but it will not be available for entry until October.

A copy of the new Residential Data Input form with the new Green fields is available here; and, a copy of the Sellers Green Disclosure Statement is available here. Both have been sent to your local board for reproduction and will soon be available in your ZipLogic library. For now you can print the documents available at this site.
